Ages 3-6

The following is a checklist of all skills a child should be able to demonstrate after experiencing DTBC's 2-year Level 1 curriculum.

Concepts from 5 of the 12 strands are introduced at this level:

There is only one true and real God.

Our God does not lie.

The Bible is God's Words.

All people are sinners.

Our God has one bloodline (begotten) Son, Jesus Christ the Savior.

Beginning to Understand

Selected vocabulary in context.

Synonyms of true and real.

The one true and real God is our God.

Not everyone worships or believes in our God.

Some people might be mean to us because of our belief in the one true God.

Jesus is God's Son.

Our God forgives sin.

Our God can live inside of us.

We can always count on our God to tell us the truth.

Our God is perfect.

Telling a lie means saying something that you know is not true.

Because our God always tells the truth, every promise of His is also true.

Beginning to Understand

Because the Bible is God's words and God doesn't lie, everything in the Bible is true.

Beginning to understand that other books cannot unequivocally be counted on for truth.

Not everyone in the world believes in or likes our God.

Not everyone in the world believes that the Bible is God's Word(s).

People may worship other gods they believe are true or real.

People may believe that truth is found in a book of their god.

God will always, always love me.

I am a sinner.

Sin makes God sad.

My heart need to be made clean from sin.

When Adam and Eve sinned, the perfect died.

Jesus came from God and is His only Son.

Jesus loves me.

Jesus died on a cross and was buried in

Demonstrates

- Given oral fill-in-the-blanks, spontaneously provides the correct word:
 - There is only one true and real God.
 - Who is God? The One who created everything; the One who has one Son Jesus. The One whose Son gave His life to save the world.
 - Who is Jesus? God's Son.
 - When people ask Jesus to forgive their sins, what happens? He makes their hearts clean from sin, AND He comes to live inside their hearts.
 - Does everyone like or believe in our God? No
 - Our God never lies.
 - Everything God says is true.
 - God always keeps His promises.
 - The Bible is God's Words.
 - Everything in the Bible is true.
 - Before Adam and Eve sinned, our world was perfect.
 - The opposite of obey is disobey.
 - God's everlasting love means it goes on and on and never stops.
 - Who is Jesus? God's only Son.
 - Why did Jesus come to earth? To make our hearts clean from sin.
 - Why did Jesus die? Because He loved us.
 - Who is the only one who can forgive our sin? Jesus
 - Where does Jesus want to live? inside of me.
- Correctly differentiates concrete examples as truth or lies.
- Correctly differentiates inferential examples as truth or lies.
- Places letters in correct word order to spell BIBLE. (Student first learns left to right progression, letter/word identification and differentiation, use of upper and lower case letters in the word BIBLE).
- Differentiates which one(s) are God's Words and which are not, given pictures and physical books, AND TELLS WHY.

Demonstrates

- Generates two or more examples of evidence that our world is no longer perfect because of the sin of Adam and Eve.
- Identifies characters' behaviors that are sinful when presented with examples.
- Describes in simple terms what happens inside of us when we sin.
- Describes in simple terms how our hearts can be clean from sin.
- Puts Biblical accounts in order when given sets of 3 illustrations.
- Accurately role plays scenes or manipulates props depicting Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection.
